TEC ACADEMIES

The TEC Creative Academy, Crime & Society Academy and Teaching Academy are new Level 3 programmes of study, which are studied over two years and include a mixture of A Level and vocational training that will prepare you for further study at university and provide you with the skills you need to succeed in the world of work.

CREATIVE ACADEMY - LEVEL 3 CREATIVE PRACTICE AND A SUBSIDIARY DIPLOMA IN VISUAL ARTS

Over two years this course looks at the creative process while developing skills through the research and application of specialist industry practices and techniques. Students will also develop technical skills through the practical application of design and drawing techniques.

This course is ideal for anyone who wants to gain a valuable insight into the world of visual arts and an understanding of the skills required for visual analysis and the consideration of a broad body of visual works in preparation for further study at university



CRIME & SOCIETY ACADEMY - LEVEL 3 CRIMINOLOGY AND A LEVELS IN PSYCHOLOGY AND SOCIOLOGY

This programme looks at an exciting and interesting range of topics that will include different approaches to psychology including cognitive, behavioural, physiological, social and areas such as relationships, memory, attachment, sleep, clinical psychology and mental health. Students will also be given the opportunity for independent research in an area of Psychology that interests them.

Students will also cover a wide range of interesting and exciting sociology topics over the two years and will have the opportunity to develop a broad set of essential academic skills, including the ability to analyse and formulate clear, logical arguments with scope for extensive evaluation from a range of theoretical perspectives.

Across the two years students will gain the knowledge to progress to employment within some aspects of the criminal justice sector or to university to study for a degree in the crime and society field.

TEACHING ACADEMY - A LEVELS IN PSYCHOLOGY, SOCIOLOGY AND AN APPLIED GENERAL AWARD IN EARLY YEARS.

The new TEC Teaching Academy will help you prepare for teacher training courses at University, and has been designed to contain complementary subjects to either work in Primary Education or within selected secondary subjects of the Further Education sector.

You will have a variety of work-based opportunities including undertaking regular placements within local schools. You will also be able to gain additional qualifications in essential areas such as Safeguarding and Fundamental British Values.

NEW T LEVELS ON OFFER AT SCARBOROUGH TEC FROM SEPTEMBER

Scarborough TEC is introducing two new T Level qualifications, available at Level 3, from September 2021 in Early Years & Childcare and Health & Science.

T Levels are nationally-recognised qualifications that have been designed with leading employers to deliver the skills young people need to continue their education at University or go straight out into the world of employment.

A T Level in Early Years & Childcare or Health & Science provides the same UCAS points as three A Levels and offers more classroom study than Apprenticeships. Students are also required to undertake an industry placement of at least 45-days to help young people learn what a real career is like.

POLICING & UNIFORMED SERVICES

This new programme combines our popular Uniformed Services course with training and theoretical knowledge that is ideal for anyone considering the Police and is available at Levels 1, 2 & 3.

The course will give you a great insight into life as a member of the Police, Fire Brigade, Royal Navy or other services such as the Army or Royal Air Force.

Teamwork, fitness and leadership form the foundation of the course where you will take part in fitness sessions, adventure activities, drills and exercises to prepare you for life in some of the most physically demanding and vital job roles there are. Work experience opportunities include placements in local youth organisations, schools and events with the RAF, Royal Marines, Army and Police.

SOCIAL SCIENCES

This programme of study is available at Level 2 and combines elements of Mental Health, Psychology, Sociology and the Social Sciences and will give you an understanding of society, the way in which people behave and how they influence the world around us.

The programme will help you use your skills, knowledge and experience to make a difference to the society that we live in. You will also look at a range of social science perspectives that will give you the chance to explore sociological, psychological and political approaches to crime and behaviour.

This course is an ideal study programme for those progressing on to our Level 3 Crime & Society Academy.





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
