Dear Parent/Carer

We're delighted to welcome you and your child to Scalby School as part our new Year 7! Hopefully by now you have managed to return the transition packs we sent out to you in June. Transition Arrangements

As part of our adapted transition visits, your son/daughter will hopefully have had a tour of the school site and got to speak to some of our staff during the visit. It has been an unusual and challenging year for everyone involved in education, and we know you and your child might be feeling especially nervous about the transition into Year 7.

- An English transition project, which you are free to download and complete with your son/daughter over the summer.


Lateral Flow Testing

When all secondary students return to school in September the Government have asked that secondary schools undertake 2 lateral flow tests with all students. These will be undertaken at our site testing facility that was used following the lockdown earlier this year. All students will undertake a test on their first day, and a second test 3 to 5 days after. In order for your son/daughter to take part in this testing, they will need you to complete an electronic consent form.
